

Safety First

When you join EURIE Summit, you can expect to see that health and safety is a priority and that a range of measures are in place to ensure everyone can enjoy a safe, hygienic, productive and high-quality event experience.

EURIE will be running according to official government and local authority guidance in the first instance, as well as any venue or location-specific regulations.

Just bring confirmation of your vaccination card and/or recent Covid test result administered in the last 48 hours and do not forget your face mask.

Cleaning & Hygiene

1. Enhanced cleaning

EURIE summit will undertake enhanced, deep cleaning before, during and after our summit, working with venue partners to ensure the highest standards of hygiene and cleanliness. This includes continuous sanitization throughout the course of the summit, with a focus on high-touch areas such as door handles, restrooms and food and beverage areas.

2. Personal hygiene

EURIE summit will provide hand washing facilities and hand sanitizing stations throughout the event spaces, encouraging all participants to regularly wash and disinfect their hands.

Physical Distancing

3. Physical contact

EURIE summit will request that participants avoid physical contact, such as handshakes and embraces, promoting alternative ways to greet business partners. The exchange of printed materials, such as business cards and sales brochures, will also be discouraged, with digital alternatives recommended.

4. Physical distancing

EURIE summit will maintain a density of participants in line with local authority regulations and venue or other relevant guidance. This will be managed through event programming, venue selection, on-site signage and on-site social distance ambassadors.

5. Food and beverage stations

EURIE summit teams will work closely with venue partners to employ the highest standard of food safety, minimizing self-service buffets in favor of pre-packaged food options. If any queuing is anticipated, social distancing will be maintained through the use of floor markings and relevant signage.

Protect & Detect

6. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Participants at EURIE summit will be asked to wear a face mask on entry. Further items of PPE, such as gloves and eye screens, will be used by participants and staff if appropriate, in line with local government and health authority advice.

7. First aid

EURIE summit will have access to a qualified first aider and a separate quarantine area if possible. Participants will be asked not to attend if they are feeling unwell, and teams will follow local health authority guidance on detecting and managing anyone who displays symptoms of COVID-19.

8. Screening

EURIE summit will follow relevant health authority guidance on screening participants. This may include checking the temperatures of everyone on entry.
