- > Accreditation of 4 staff development programmes in Australia



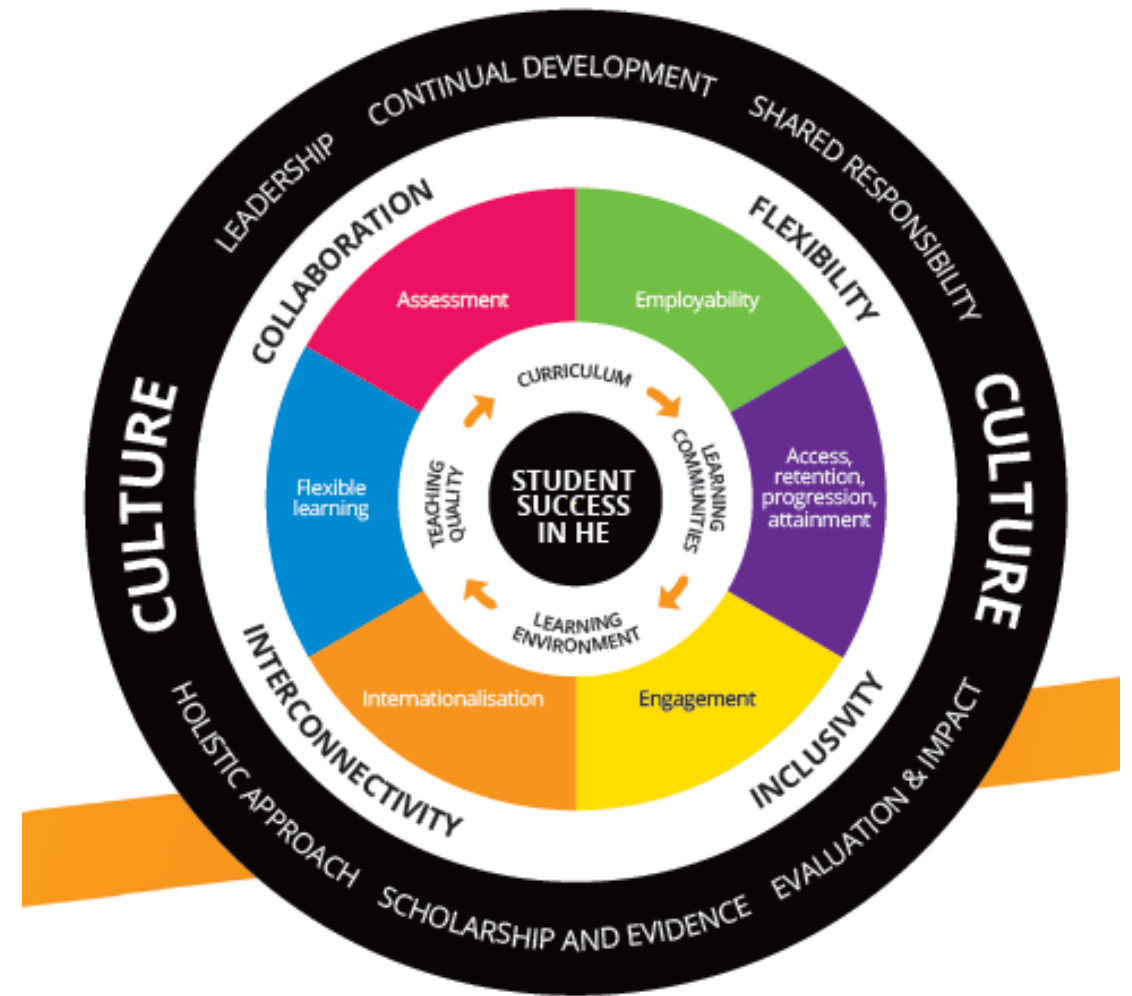
Membership
